For 2025, our highest priority requests of the Board of Commissioners:

- 1. Budget additional staff positions in 2025-26 to support the new Sustainability Officer. (One approved)
- 2. Budget \$50,000+ for a Survey of County Businesses to identify and support the best of their sustainability plans.
- 3. Set a goal for County facilities and vehicles to meet NREL's plan to run on 100% clean energy by 2035.
- 4. Partner with Georgia Tech (Dr. Garcia) on a climate risk assessment for the County. (in process)

- 5. Engage the County's School District and regional colleges to ensure our County sustainability goals and actions are aligned with theirs.
- 6. Where immediate cost savings are available, develop a plan to reduce County LCOE, and Operating Expenses by at least \$3M/yr on average, by installing solar on county buildings and transitioning county fleets to electric vehicles. Then, as taxpayer dollars are saved each year, establish a method to redeploy those funds to limit County households spending on electricity to no more than 20% of their monthly income.
