The Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners is soliciting competitive sealed bids from qualified contractors for the **Brooks Road Pump Station Odor Control Modifications**. Sealed bids will be received by the Gwinnett County Department of Financial Services - Purchasing Division-2nd Floor, 75 Langley Drive, Lawrenceville, Georgia 30046 until **2:50 P.M. local time on August 19, 2015** and then publicly opened and read aloud at 3:00 P.M. Any bid received after 2:50 P.M. will not be accepted. Bid envelope must be marked on the outside with Bid Number, name of Bidder, date and time of opening. Contractor providing the utility work must have a current valid Utility Contractors License.

The work includes: Remove and properly dispose of existing carbon and replace with County provided non-generable carbon in two radial flow carbon vessels, clean and inspect interior of vessels, add lever mechanisms to grease filter door, recoat fiberglass ductwork, replace cover plates around manifold piping, replace damaged differential pressure gauges and switches, add sunshades to all instrumentation, repair and modify drain piping, replace existing actuator hand wheels, and any other items needed to make the Project complete.

A **pre-bid conference** is scheduled for 10:00 A.M. on August 05, 2015 at the Gwinnett County Purchasing Division, above address. A site visit will follow. **All pre-qualified bidders are strongly urged to attend.**

Questions regarding bids should be submitted to Holly Cafferata, CPPB, Purchasing Manager, at fax 770-822-8728, or email holly.cafferata@gwinnettcountry.com no later than 3:00 p.m. local time, August 06, 2015. Bids are legal and binding upon the bidder when submitted.

Bids in the case of Corporations not chartered in Georgia, must be accompanied by proper certification stating that said Corporation is authorized to do business in the State of Georgia.

No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within ninety (90) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Bidder agrees to complete the Contract awarded within the "allowable calendar days for completion" from the date of the "Notice to Proceed" and he further agrees that the Owner may retain from the monies which may become due the amount of **Substantial Completion/\$1,000 per day; Final Completion/\$1,000 per day** for each and every day that the completion of the work may be delayed.

All suppliers must submit with bid, a bid bond, certified check or cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid. **Failure to submit a bid bond with the proper rating will result in the bid being deemed non-responsive.** Successful supplier will be required to meet insurance requirements, submit a one hundred percent (100%) performance bond and a one hundred percent (100%) payment bond. Insurance and Bonding Company should be licensed to do business by the Georgia Secretary of State, authorized to do business in Georgia by The Georgia Insurance Department, listed in the Department of Treasury's Publication of Companies holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Surety on Federal Bonds and as acceptable reinsuring companies. **The bid bond, payment bond, and performance bond must have an A.M. Best rating of A-5 or higher.**

All bonds should be submitted on forms provided by Gwinnett County and agencies providing bonds and insurance should provide proof that they meet the criteria outlined in the bid and contract documents.

The County will award the Contract to the lowest "qualified" bidder, subject with the Owner's right to reject any or all bids, to waive technicalities, and to make an award deemed in its best interests. With limited response, Gwinnett County reserves the right to extend the solicitation opening date as appropriate in order to assure a competitive procurement process.
