The Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners is soliciting competitive sealed bids from qualified contractors for the **George Pierce Park Baseball Plaza and Associated Landscape Improvements** for the Gwinnett County Department of Community Services.

Bids should be typed or submitted in ink and returned in a sealed container marked on the outside with the BL# and Company Name. Bids will be received until 2:50 P.M. local time on **October 20, 2016** at the Gwinnett County Purchasing Office, 75 Langley Drive, Lawrenceville, Georgia 30046. Any bid received after this date and time will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read at 3:00 P.M. Apparent bid results will be available the following business day on our website [www.gwinnettcountry.com](http://www.gwinnettcountry.com).

A **pre-bid conference** is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on **October 6, 2016** at the Gwinnett Purchasing Office at the above address.. All contractors are urged to attend. Bids are legal and binding upon the bidder when submitted. All bids should be submitted in duplicate.

The scope of work includes demolition as needed to construct new ADA concrete path from parking to concession building, add shade arbor with picnic tables at front of concession building, repair highly eroded landscape area and re-landscape with store water improvements, move flag pole, and new picnic outdoor dining area in mulch zone at rear of building, landscape plaza area with new trees, sod, vines, and groundcovers, re-landscape eroding slopes ascending to the parking lot with reforestation planting protected by fencing.

All contractors must submit with bid, a bid bond, certified check or cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid. **Failure to submit a bid bond with the proper rating will result in the bid being deemed non-responsive.** Successful contractor will be required to meet insurance requirements, submit a one hundred percent (100%) performance bond and a one hundred percent (100%) payment bond. Insurance and Bonding Company should be licensed to do business by the Georgia Secretary of State, authorized to do business in Georgia by The Georgia Insurance Department, listed in the Department of Treasury's Publication of Companies holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Surety on Federal Bonds and as acceptable reinsuring companies. **The bid bond, payment bond, and performance bond must have an A.M. Best rating of A-5 or higher.**
