### ADDENDUM #3 BL011-21, Cemetery Field Synthetic Turf Replacement and Improvements

This addendum is being issued to provide clarification and answer questions received.

#### Questions:

- Q1. In Section 32 9720 1.2.E.3. of the turf specification it states that; "Manufacturer of turf system, warrantor, and installer shall be the same company." Does this mean that the only possible bidders will be turf manufacturers that directly employ their own removal and installation crews? Are subcontractors and/or contractors, who are not manufacturers, allowed to bid?
- A1. **Bidders do not have to be the turf manufacturer. It is not the intent of this bid to exclude qualified contractors from submitting or the use of sub-contractors in performance of this work. To clarify this statement, the same entity shall be responsible for the product, the warranty and the installation.**
- Q2. Under 1.1 SCOPE OF WORK A. of the Synthetic Turf Specification it states that the synthetic turf system shall be a 100% polyethylene fibers (slit-film). Then further descriptions state that it needs to be a dual-fiber (monofilament/slit-film) product. Please confirm if it is to be a 100% slit-film or dual-fiber product or if either is acceptable.
- A2. **Please disregard the reference to slit film in Section 32 9720.1.1.A.1. The intended product is the dual-fiber system as stated throughout the bid documents.**
- Q3. Are the bid dates and times correct?
- A3. **Yes**
- Q4. What is the budget estimate for the cost of construction?
- A4. **There is approved funding for this project. Gwinnett County expects each contractor to bid a competitive price. Award will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.**

This addendum should be acknowledged in the line provided on the Contractor Information Page. Failure to do so may result in your bid being deemed non-responsive.
