**I. Questions:**

**Q1. Will Gwinnett County be using it for balancing, modal data, transient data or route based data?**

A1. Currently, Gwinnett County uses collectors for transient data and route based data. The County is requesting that the units set up for balancing and modal data for future use.

**Q2. Does Gwinnett County need the software with it as well?**

A2. Per the spec we will require all identified software to be installed on the analyzer. The County is currently using SKF Aptitude on the server as part of daily operations. At present, there is no immediate requirement for the updated version of Observer unless the County transitions to online monitoring in the future.

**Q3. Is the County currently using any software? I see that there is a request for software support, but not clear if the County currently has a license/licenses.**

A3. The County is currently using SKF Aptitude. While the County may not require immediate software updates, the option of accessing software support if needed for technical assistance within the time frame requested.

**Q4. Does Gwinnett County currently have any analyzers that the County would be looking to trade in?**

A4. Not at this time.
