Provide Aviation Demand Professional Services on an Annual Contract**

**Question and Answers from the State of Georgia:**

**Q1. Will the deadline for the proposal be extended to allow for the required 30-day advertisement period as required by the FAA? It only shows 20 total between the advertisement date and the deadline.**

A1. "The FAA does not establish a time frame for how long a sponsor must advertise RFQs/RFPs and only requires 'sufficient time' be provided. The County has determined that advertising for 20 days provides sufficient time for responses."

**Q2. If the submittal of the fees are not required until after the award of the RFP, page 43, then how can the award be made on the lowest cost per letter D on page 43?**

A2. Cost will NOT be used as a scoring factor in this request for proposals. Any tie score will be resolved based on consultant qualifications. FAA regulations will be followed to the letter for the scoring and evaluation of this proposal.

**Q3. The engineering and planning are not separate. Will this be 2 proposals or do they intend to just have us add planning projects and then identify if we are submitting for one or both?**

A3. As stated in response to previously submitted questions – NO planning projects will be awarded under this solicitation. Any major planning project (e.g., Master Plan Study, FAR Part 150 Study, etc.) will be awarded under a separate solicitation if/when the project is necessary.
