**I. Revision:**

- R1. Please update the bid title from "~~Sewer and Assessment Program on a Multi-Year Contract~~" to "**Sewer and Stormwater Assessment Program on a Multi-Year Contract**" throughout the Invitation to Bid documents. Please use the revised bid documents in Attachment A1.
- R2. Invitation to Bid, Page 74, 3.2 – Please **remove** "No" before *References should detail the experience of the Contractor with similar projects and other relevant experience.*

**II. Questions:**

- Q1. Please provide the bid tabulation from the last time this contract was bid out and the most recent renewal tabulation.**
- A1. Please see Attachment A2. BL098-20 Award Tabulation (December 2020) and A3. BL098-20 Renewal Tabulation (January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025)
- Q2. Please confirm if the pre-bid conference is mandatory or not.**
- A2. No, the pre-bid conference is not mandatory to attend.
- Q3. Are any contractor, business or waste hauler licenses required to bid or to do the specified work?**
- A3. This is considered a trade specific project; therefore a Contractor's license is not required. However, the Contractor, as well as all sub-contractors utilized by the Contractor, must be properly licensed in the State of Georgia.
- Q4. On page 74 of the Invitation, in Section 3.2 References/Experience/Requirements of the Contractor, there seems to be a typo with the addition of "no": *No References should detail the experience of the Contractor with similar projects and other relevant experience.***
- A4. Please see Revision R2.
- Q5. Will the annual 100% performance and payment bonds be applied to 1 Year's bid total, or total for all 5-years of work?**
- A5. All Bidders are required to submit a Bid Bond, or a certified check made payable to the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total amount bid. The Bid Bond or certified check must be enclosed in the envelope with the sealed bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a 100% Performance Bond and Payment Bond, based on the estimated amount to be spent for year one and provide insurance coverage as required by the contract documents. The payment and performance bond amounts are subject to change per renewing year. Each awarded contractor will be provided the required bond amount each year following award and will be required to provide bonds for that amount.

**Q6. Is it the County's intention to award to one (1) or multiple vendors?**

A6. Gwinnett County's intent is to award to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder per section.

**Q7. Please confirm the contracts intent is to clean to TV the pipe?**

A7. Pipes should be sufficiently cleaned so as to allow for clear viewing of all of the interior surfaces of the lines during television inspection.

**Q8. Please provide a better description of what the process is for the Hydrogen Sensor line item.**

A8. Please refer to Section Y; Page 83.

**Q9. Will the contractor be responsible for cleaning and televising all non-round closed storm conduit? If so, how should the size range be allocated to the diameter sizes found in the spec?**

A9. Yes, non-round sizes will be matched to the closest equivalent area round sizes specified in the contract.

**Q10. Does Gwinnett County have a landfill or approved dump locations for the storm / sewer debris from the lines?**

A10. The Contractor shall be responsible for dumping locations for storm/sewer debris.

**Q11. Would you accept \$5MM in Professional Liability coverage in lieu of a Bid Bond and Payment and Performance Bonds?**

A11. No, Gwinnett County is requiring that all contractors submit with bid, a bid bond, certified check or cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid. Failure to submit a bid bond with the proper rating will result in the bid being deemed non-responsive. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a 100% Performance Bond and Payment Bond, based on the estimated amount to be spent for year one and provide insurance coverage as required by the contract documents. The payment and performance bond amounts are subject to change per renewing year. Each awarded contractor will be provided the required bond amount each year following award and will be required to provide bonds for that amount.

**Q12. Section 3 – Information to Be Provided in Bid (Section 3.3, pg. 47 of 138) This section outlines a requirement for 5 years of experience for the Project Manager, 3 years for the Data Manager, and for all personnel conducting inspections to be PACP-certified or to obtain certification prior to the commencement of work. However, this seems to conflict with Section 1.4 – Experience, which states that CCTV technicians should have a minimum of 3 years of experience. Does this 3-year experience requirement refer solely to operating the CCTV truck/robot, rather than requiring a PACP certification for 3 years? Could you clarify the expectation for staff experience?**

A12. CCTV Technicians should be PACP certified. In addition to the certification, they should have a minimum of 3 years experience in performing television/zoom camera inspections including safe working practices, proper assignment of NASSCO's condition assessment codes, etc. Certification and experience should be provided upon request from Gwinnett County.

- Q13. Section 1.5 – Measurement and Payment, Subsection D (pg. 49 of 138) Can you clarify the requirement for providing an outfitted vehicle and driver to support the County? Does this mean the contractor is expected to provide transportation for Gwinnett County personnel for reconnaissance surveys, and would this be at the contractor’s expense? If so, could you provide an example situation where this may be necessary, as well as an estimated demand for such services?**
- A13. Gwinnett County staff will have their own vehicle and will not be transported by the Contractor. However, the Contractor shall be equipped with their own vehicle to provide services listed in the referenced section.
- Q14. Manhole/Structure Inspections (Level 1 & 2) For manhole/structure inspections, would Gwinnett County approve the use of HD 360° camera inspection equipment, capable of post-processing NASSCO coding, to meet inspection requirements?**
- A14. MACP Level 1 & 2 inspections should be conducted as described in the specifications of the contract.
- Q15. In the attribute fields for both systems there is a field that dictates if the FacilityID is County maintained. Does the scope only entail County maintained assets as marked in the aforementioned attribute field?**
- A15. Yes, it is intended to only assign County maintained infrastructure. However, unmapped systems directly connected to the assigned inspection, which may or may not be County maintained systems, shall be inspected up to the first connected pipe and structure in series.
- Q16. There is a considerable amount of pressurized sewer main in the Sewer System. The spec does not call out or make mention of any pressurized sewer main. I was wondering if you could clarify if the pressurized sewer main is included in this scope, or is it isolated to gravity only. If the scope does include pressurized sewer main, will the county provide aid with operations required to perform this work?**
- A16. The assessment scope will be performed on the gravity system. In the event of a pressurized sewer main needing to be assessed, the County will provide aide with operations required to perform this work.
- Q17. It states in the spec that GIS will be provided to the contractor with the annual years scope on it. Will that be provided as .shp/.gdb files? Or does the county host the dashboard?**
- A17. Each assignment will be issued via geodatabase or .shp file.
- Q18. The spec makes mention that the GIS will include the annual years scope on it. Is it to be assumed that the quantities, 600,000 LF of light cleaning and 600,000 of televising, will be marked as such as it relates to general execution of the cleaning and televising scope of the project? Can we make the same assumptions for the other work dictated by the scope, minus the Critical Crossing Assessment?**
- A18. The quantities provided represent an estimated annual quantity based on historical averages. The labor and materials line item quantities are based on a five (5) year period, also based on histroial averages.

**Q19 For the 300,000 linear foot difference between cleaning and televising, is it to be assumed this will primarily be inspection work, and any findings will be carried out per annum if cleaning is found to be needed?**

A19. The difference represents the historical ratio of pipes the were assessed and did not require cleaning.

**Q20. Is it to be assumed the Sewer Lateral Launching (both from Main and Ground) will be in tandem to the scope of cleaning and televising work?**

A20. Yes, sewer lateral launching will also be accompanied by an assessment on the associated main.

**Q21. What volume of work is expected to be released annually (either in quantity or budget amount)?**

A21. Estimated annual quantities are included in the invitation to bid.

**Q22. What will be the typical work release size?**

A22. Work will be issued out in annual or bi-annual batches. Special assignments may be issued throughout the year as the need arises.

**Q23. Would Gwinnett County consider extending the bid due date by 7 calendar days?**

A23. No, the bid deadline will remain the same.
