**I. Questions:**

**Q1. How did Gwinnett County determine the approximate weight?**

A1. Gwinnett County Department of Water Resources weighed the boxes on County scales. Per the Invitation to Quote, *The approximate weight shown on the Quote Schedule is for bidding and evaluation purposes only. The actual weight may vary. It is the bidding Contractor’s responsibility to view items and to submit a quote based on evaluation. Gwinnett County is not responsible for accuracy of the stated quantities or weights. The amount paid to Gwinnett County will be based on the quoted price per pound amount and the certified weight slips. Following award after weighing, the successful Bidder shall provide the County with weight certification as described on the Quote Schedule. The certified weight slips shall show the date, vehicle gross, tare, and net weights. The total amount due the County written in ink or typed on the successful Contractor’s company letterhead shall accompany the certified weight slips.*

**Q2. How many boxes of meters is there, one or two?**

A2. There are 15 boxes of meters.
