ADDENDUM #1
BL077-26, Provision of Equipment and Services for Trash Removal, Disposal, and Recovered Materials Hauling on a Multi-Year Contract

Clarifications:

- C1. There are two rental (2) compactors needed at the Sheriff's Office, 2900 University Parkway and one (1) at Corrections, 750 Hi Hope Road. The compactor at the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center, 75 Langley Drive, is owned by the County and no other equipment is needed at this location.**

Revisions:

- R1. Revise Section 8 (Missed Collections) on the invitation to bid to remove "four" from the requirement to respond following notification of a missed collection. Please see below:**

In the event that individual units are missed during regular scheduled collection or if missed during a pre arranged special event where it is determined that the container must be emptied or removed (ie: from a roadway), the service provider shall have ~~four~~ (24) hours after they are contacted to provide service. Failure to do so (except in the case of emergencies) may result in the County obtaining the needed service elsewhere and charging the cost of performance to the service provider by deducting said cost from the monthly invoice.

Questions:

- Q1. Is this bid for residential or commercial removal, disposal, and recovered materials hauling?**
A1. This contract is for commercial services for Gwinnett County facilities only.
- Q2. Should commercial franchise fees to the County be included in pricing?**
A2. Yes, all fees must be included in unit pricing. The County will not pay for charges not included on the Bid Schedule.
- Q3. Is a bid for every line item required?**
A3. Interested bidders are not required to bid on every District. However, any District(s) bid on do require all line items to be completed within that District for all five years.
- Q4. When calculating total price on the bid schedule, (Price * Price * # of Tons + Price per Haul), pricing is dependent on the number of tons. Will the total tons for the open top and compactor locations, or should the input haul fee and tonnage the input haul fee and tonnage fee be without number of tons?**
A4. Please see the Revised Bid Schedule attached. Formulas for calculating pricing are included for applicable columns. The formula for applicable columns will be (Cost Per Haul*#of Hauls) + (Price Per Ton*#of Tons).

- Q5. Please provide clarity on what a fullness monitoring system is on the compactors. Would pressure gauges be acceptable?**
- A5. This is requesting a monitoring system that will notify the awarded hauler and County representative when the dumpster is full and requires service.
- Q6. How can the dumpsters or compactors listed in the invitation to bid be viewed in-person?**
- A6. Please reach out to Jordan.Mitchell@GwinnettCounty.com or 770-822-5491 by April 23, 2026, to schedule a site visit.
- Q7. Will the County award based off each district or lowest bidder of each line item?**
- A7. Gwinnett County reserves the right to award this contract to the service provider with the overall low or the low by each district. A hauler could be awarded between one to four districts.
- Q8. The invitation to bid regarding the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center, 75 Langley Drive, asks for specification sheets to be included with the bid but also states that the County owns the compactor. Does a replacement compactor need to be included in pricing or just the monitoring unit and deodorizer?**
- A8. The County does own the compactor located at the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center. The rented compactors included in bids, that this section references, are for the two (2) at the Sheriff's Office at 2900 University Parkway and one (1) at Corrections, 750 Hi Hope Road.
- Q9. At 75 Langley Drive, where does the pricing for the deodorizer need to be included on the bid schedule?**
- A9. No need for the deodorizing system at 75 Langley Drive. The deodorizers will need to be included in the two (2) rented compactors at the Sheriff's Office, 2900 University Parkway, and one (1) rented compactor at Corrections, 750 Hi Hope Road.
- Q10. How or who will manage the deodorizer chemicals at 75 Langley Drive once the County purchases them?**
- A10. There is no need for the deodorizing system at 75 Langley Drive.
- Q11. Do all compactors need to be washed out?**
- A11. No, only the two compactors at the Sheriff's Office, located at 2900 University Parkway.
- Q12. How should compactor washout be charged?**
- A12. There is a line item on the Bid Schedule for this charge, Flat Rate Fee Per Washout and Sanitizing Service.
- Q13. How will compactors be washed out that are not being hauled every week?**
- A13. Only the two (2) compactors at the Sheriff's Office at 2900 University Parkway are to be washed, and it will be after each haul.
- Q14. What is the current demand for washouts for each department?**
- A14. Currently, the two (2) compactors at the Sheriff's Office at 2900 University Parkway are the only washouts.
- Q15. Do compactor specification sheets need to be included with our bid or after award? If they are to be included in the bid, where should this be supplied in the package?**
- A15. Please include specification sheets with your sealed bid.

Q16. Do the monitoring devices need to feed an online system?

A16. The monitoring systems need to send information to the hauler and the County that it is ready to pulled.

Q17. How many total deodorizer systems are needed and at what locations?

A17. There are three (3) in total. Two (2) are located at the Sheriff's Office located at 2900 University Parkway and one (1) at Corrections located at 750 Hi Hope Rd.

Q18. Are there any other specific additional systems or specifications needed for compactors?

A18. No, the bidders should submit pricing based on what is included in the specifications and the Bid Schedule.

Q19. In the pre-bid conference, it was stated that the awarded service provider would only have twenty-four (24) hours to recover any missed collection service, but in the invitation to bid, it states, "the service provider shall have four (24) hours after they are contacted to provide service." Does this equate to four (4) days?

A19. This is listed under the revisions section of this addendum and will be 24 hours from the time the hauler is contacted of a missed collection.

Q20. In the pre-bid conference, it was mentioned that invoicing and billing should be done through the portal. Is this required? Can you explain the portal in further detail?

A20. Suppliers are strongly encouraged to submit invoices through the portal, but it is not required. The Oracle platform is utilized to issue purchase orders to suppliers or service providers, and for suppliers to manage any open or existing orders. To submit a bid, you do not have to be registered; However, the awarded hauler must be registered before an award is made.

Q21. Page six (6) of the invitation to bid states, "Service provider should submit specification sheets on the monitoring system offered for rent to be placed on three (3) 34 cubic yard compactors." However, on page five (5), only two (2) locations are listed. Please clarify.

A21. There are three monitoring systems total being requested. Two (2) will be located at the Sheriff's Office located at 2900 University Pkwy and one (1) at Corrections located at 750 Hi Hope Road.

Q22. What is the intended start date for this contract?

A22. Contract to begin August 5, 2026 or upon Board of Commissioners approval.

Q23. Who currently provides these services?

A23. Waste Management, Waste Eliminator, Republic Services, and City of Lawrenceville in the areas part of this solicitation.

Q24. Please provide a copy of the most recent invoices for these services.

A24. To view invoices, please submit an open records request at the Gwinnett County website, www.GwinnettCounty.com.

Q25. Please provide the annual tons collected for each service type.

A25. Please see the Revised Bid Schedule. Bidders must submit on the Revised Bid Schedule. Failure to submit on the Revised Bid Schedule may result in bid being deemed non-responsive.
