Purchase and Delivery of a Treadmill and Elliptical**

Please see a summation of the questions and answers below for the referenced solicitation.

Questions:

- Q1. Would vendors be removing and disposing of any equipment with this delivery? In other words, are these replacing old ones the County wants removed?
A1. Yes. There is old equipment that the vendor will need to remove.
- Q2. The elliptical specified is a "suspension" design elliptical. Will other ellipticals that are not of the suspension design be considered as "approved equivalent" as long as the max user weight, stride length, and pedal spacing are comparable to the model specified?
A2. The County will review equivalents that are quoted and determine if they are acceptable. It is understood that items matching or exceeding the quality level are also acceptable. Gwinnett County shall be the sole determinant of acceptability of all approved equivalents. It is the vendor's responsibility to prove equivalent products match or exceed the quality level of the product(s) specified.
- Q3. Do both stations have ground floor access to the fitness room?
A3. Yes.
- Q4. The treadmill specified has an AC drive motor. Will treadmills that have DC drive motors be considered "approved equivalent" as long as top speed, max incline, and max user weight are the same or higher than the AC model specified?
A4. See A2.
